<ul> <li>Practice 2 digit addition and subtraction fact fluency by playing "war" with a deck of cards, using flashcards, verbal quizzes in the car on your way to an activity or vacation or printing off a timed test.</li> <li>Have your child read an analog clock to tell you the time and count coins from piggy banks as often as possible.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use the <u>UFLI Toolkit</u> to print and use: Roll-and-Reads and Passages</li> <li>Offer your child a spelling test multiple times throughout the Summer.</li> <li>Discuss the meaning of new words and vocabulary. Listen for common prefixes and suffixes or context clues to help decipher meaning.</li> <li>*Second grade left off on list 98 from the above UFLI website, (silent letters.)</li> <li>*Use lists for second grade review, or click ahead to help them prepare for 3rd grade.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Read a chapter book out loud as a family.</li> <li>Read choice books for 25 minutes a day.</li> <li>Does your child have a library card?
